## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This registration does not entitle you to carry out the activities of a security adviser or security equipment installer. You must hold a current private security individual operator registration with the relevant security activities to carry out these activities.
2. You must not transfer, lend or give your registration to another person or business.
3. Your registration must be produced on request to any member of Victoria Police.
4. Your registration must be produced on request to any person you are providing services to under the authority of this registration.
5. If you are charged with an indictable offence during the course of your registration you must notify Licensing & Regulation Division within 7 days of being charged, of the offence you were charged with and the date and place of the hearing. It is an offence under section 176 of the Private Security Act 2004 not to notify LRD of charges.
6. If a close associate of the business is charged with an indictable offence during the course of your registration they must notify Licensing & Regulation Division within 7 days of being charged, of the offence they were charged with and the date and place of the hearing. It is an offence under section 176 of the Private Security Act 2004 not to notify LRD of charges.
7. If at any time during the course of your registration a person becomes a close associate or ceases to be a close associate to the business you must notify Licensing & Regulation Division in writing immediately. It is an offence under section 174 not to notify LRD of changes to close associates.
8. If at any time during the course of your registration a person becomes an officer of the body corporate or ceases to be an officer of the body corporate, you must notify Licensing & Regulation Division in writing immediately. It is an offence under section 175 not to notify LRD of changes to officers.
9. You must take all reasonable steps to ensure that your registration number is included on any published advertisement relating to or in connection with the business. It is an offence under section 130 of the Private Security Act 2004 not to include your registration number in advertising material.
10. You must notify the Licensing & Regulation Division of any change in address of the principal place of business within 7 days of the change via mail, facsimile or e-mail.
11. If your registration is lost or stolen, you must apply for a duplicate by contacting the Licensing & Regulation Division. A statutory declaration is required and a fee is to be paid prior to a duplicate registration being issued.
12. You must not provide the services of another person to carry on the activities of a security adviser or security equipment installer unless they hold a current private security individual operator registration that authorises them to carry on that activity. It is an offence under section 131 of the Private Security Act 2004 to provide the services of unlicensed persons.
13. You must display a copy of the registration certificate at each premises from which the business operates. It is an offence under section 133 of the Private Security Act 2004 not to display the registration document.
14. You must keep permanent records as outlined in section 134 of the Private Security Act 2004 and as prescribed by the Private Security Regulations 2016 for at least 5 years.
15. Every application or document submitted by the body corporate under the Private Security Act 2004 and Private Security Regulations 2016 must be completed by the nominated person.
16. If at any time during the course of this licence the nominated person ceases to be the nominated person or ceases to be a qualified person, Licensing & Regulation Division must be notified immediately.
